- I. A Private Office
- II. A faculty colleague who is a professional computer scientist
- III. A normal load consisting of the following:
  - 1. Two courses per semester plus department chairman responsibilities.
  - Supervise student independent study and research projects (usually at least 3 a semester).
  - Arrange, coordinate, and supervise the departmental internship program.
  - 4. Work with local high schools to implement computer usage. This would include the creation and maintenance of a library of materials, consultation with schools on special needs, and conducting workshops and special sessions for teachers and administrators.
  - 5. Work with Hope College faculty in other departments to stimulate and encourage computer use. This would include supervision of a staff of student programmers who could be assigned to projects under my direction to serve faculty needs in research and/or instruction.   - Solicit, coordinate, and provide continuing education programs in computer science.
  - IV. Summer appointment available to work on 4.5, and 7 above and to perform other tasks as required in the computer center.
